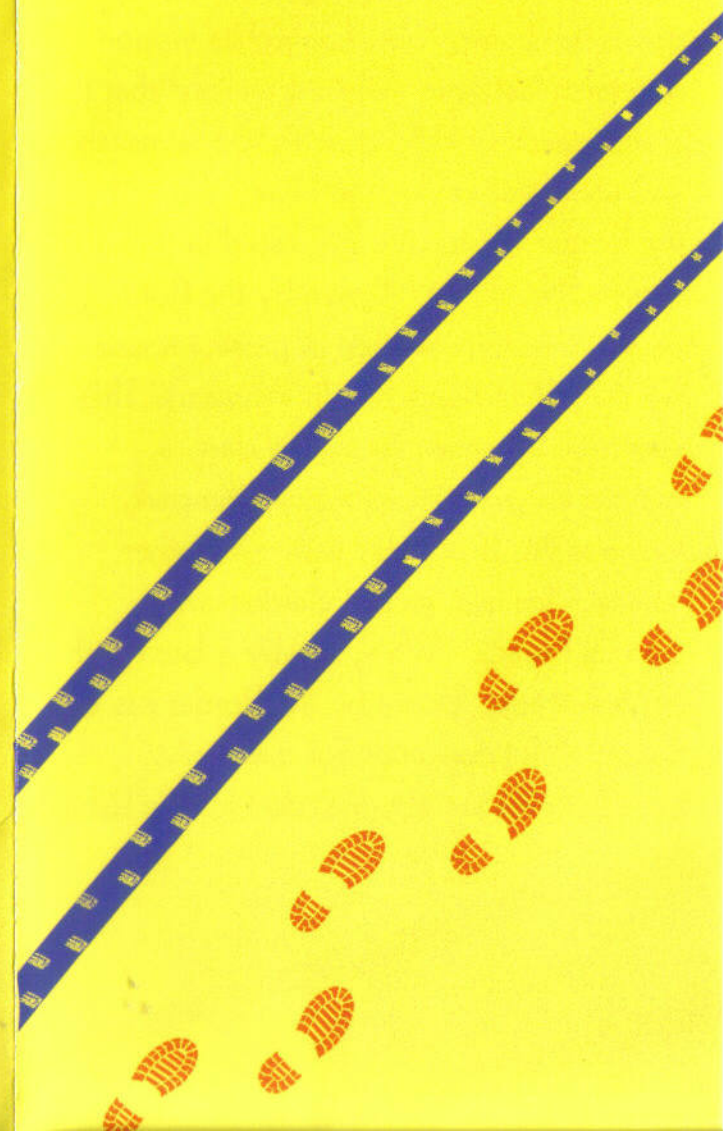

They also have a summer swimming class, a summer art program, picnics in the park, movie night, beach day and many other activities for families and children with Special Needs. When a baby is born with special needs, Down by the Border has a basket with information for the family, beautiful gifts are also included for the baby.
